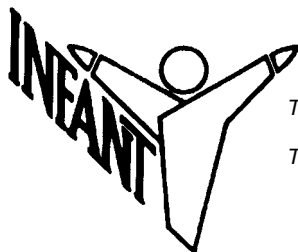

We are particularly happy to send you our report this year. It shows we have delivered nearly two million dollars in food and infant clothing during the twenty five years since our founding. We celebrate what you have enabled us to do for babies in need in our area.

Recently we had an opportunity to spend a morning visiting two of our agencies to become more knowledgeable about their current programs. We wanted to assure ourselves that your gifts are being used well and are truly helpful. We were very impressed with the professionals who work with these parents and children.

Many mothers are healing from drug use. Many young mothers are finishing school and developing skills to improve their job prospects while they work at minimum wage jobs. Many are attending parenting classes to learn how to give their children a loving environment free of abuse, which should help them toward a happy future, despite present poverty.

Maintaining these supportive programs is challenging for the agencies. Requests to them are increasing and they in turn are asking us for more help with the youngest of their clients. As costs for basic needs rise some families are falling farther behind. Our baby formula means families can nourish their babies well, even in financial emergencies.
